Looking for Learning

As an ISP school, Hamilton is ensuring that students have amazing learning journeys, and this starts in the classroom. The leadership and staff have started conducting regular 'Looking for Learning' focused lesson observations to ensure the focus of each lesson is student learning. These observations involve discussing with the students what they are learning, how they are learning the material and how has each students' knowledge, skills and understanding grown in that lesson. Hamilton's goal is for 80% of students to be actively learning, 80% of the lesson time. Our focus of professional development has been improving student achievement in the lessons. It has been exciting and rewarding this month to be able to discuss learning with the students.

The Hamilton Support Hub

In association with the Ontario Center for Special Education we have developed the Hamilton Support Hub to provide support for our students with special needs. The support provided covers speech therapy, physiotherapy, music therapy, occupational therapy, psychologists, and the provision of specialist teacher aides. The Hamilton Support Hub is an important part of our community and it is great to see the successes they are having in a caring supportive environment. All students have a comprehensive Individual Education Plan (IEP) to specifically support them with their goals. They are also involved in swimming, PE, music and classroom integration as appropriate to their IEP, which is so important for their confidence and well-being.
