BACK TO SCHOOL



PRE-KG - GRADE 1

Review of sanitization procedures upon entry of classroom with reinforcement throughout the day, introduction to safe bubbles and multi-sensory play. Movement between classroom and shared play area in small group rotations.

GRADES 2 - 5

Students greeted new classmates, learned about safety measures and were introduced to their safe bubbles. Focus on "All About Me" unit, practiced times tables, and participated in activities with their classmates who dialed in remotely.

GRADES 6 - 8

Introduction to safe bubbles, personal goal setting and several activities with their classmates dialing in remotely. Students participated in a tower building competition, selecting a soundtrack to represent their life, and drawing.

SAFETY MEASURES

MOPH has outlined measures to keep schools safe in Qatar. Rest assured that at Hamilton, we take safety measures very seriously. Here are some of the precautionary measures that we have implemented to keep our community safe.

- Thermal cameras capturing all students', parents' and visitors' temperature upon entry to the primary school building.
- Temperature control station for the sports hall access.
- Different entrances and exits for various year groups as per the Welcome Pack procedures. For more information see our <u>video</u> illustrating entry and exit points.
- One-way systems throughout the school with stickers reminding us to keep a safe distance.
- Maximum of 15 students per classroom with a safe distance of 1.5 meters between each student in class.
- Hand sanitizer located in every classroom and all common areas.
- Use of safe bubbles to maintain safe distances and to avoid crosscontamination.
- Increased cleaning capacity throughout the school.
