#### Primary ECAs Q&A



• How do I sign up for ECAs?

In order to register your child, you must complete the form and hand to your child's class teacher

What are the ECAs and when are they taking place?

ECAs are free of charge activities run by the Hamilton staff, and they take place from Monday to Thursday from 2:00 PM to 2:45 PM.

Where do I pick up my child from their ECA?

You will enter school through the normal way. Please carry out the same process. Pick up begins at 2.45pm and finishes at 3.00pm.

What if I am late to pick up my child?

Please appreciate that our staff members also have commitments out of school hours. Please be prompt in picking up your child/children at 2.45pm from their classroom. Any students that are picked up late will be waiting in reception. If you pick up your child late on more than one occasion in a term, then your child's seat will be removed from the ECA for the term.

If my child has a sporting ECA, can they wear their PE kit to school?

Yes. If your child has a sporting ECA, they may come into school in their PE kit.

Can I change ECA midterm?

Activities will rotate and change on a termly basis to ensure students participate in a range of activities. If your child signs up to an ECA for the term, that is the ECA they will remain in until the end of the term.

How many students participate in each ECA?

Number of students might vary accordingly to each activity.

#### · What clubs are there?

**ECAs:** Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, Extra-Curricular Activities are free of charge and ran by Hamilton staff.

**Note:** Students can choose their ECAs option from the selection above.

**ASAs:** These After School Activities incur a charge and are ran by external providers. A booklet with all the options for the current academic year will be shared by email

When will the ECAs begin?

ECAs for Semester 1 will begin on Sunday 10th September 2024

• How do I sign up for ECAs?

Students will have the opportunity to complete the registration survey during the homeroom class.

• What are the ECAs and when are they taking place?

**ECAs** are free of charge activities run by the Hamilton staff, and they take place from Sunday to Thursday from 2:00 PM to 2:50 PM.

Where do I pick up my child from their ECA?

You will enter school through the normal way. Please carry out the same process. Pick up begins at 2.50pm and finishes at 3.00pm.

• What if I am late to pick up my child?

Please appreciate that our staff members also have commitments out of school hours. Please be prompt in picking up your child/children at 2.50pm. Any students that are picked up late will be waiting in reception. If my child has a sporting ECA, can they wear their PE kit to school?

No. Students must bring their PE kit and change for the activity. Lockers are available for students to store their kit during the day.

Can I change ECA midterm?

Activities will rotate and change on a semester basis to ensure students participate in a range of activities. Sports ECAs will change more regularly, according to the external fixtures calendar which runs between local schools. However, within Secondary there will be some flexibility for movement between ECAs during the semester.

How many students participate in each ECA?

Number of students might vary accordingly to each activity.

Do I need to bring anything specific for my child's ASA?

Your child's ECAs teacher will communicate with you if you are required to bring anything specific for the club.

### Hamilton Hub & Early Intervention ECAs & ASAs

#### **Key Information**

- ECAs (Extra Curricular Activities) run from Sunday to Wednesday's in Inclusion, 2:00pm to 2.50pm. They are free of charge and are ran by Hamilton staff.
- -ECAs begin on Sunday 10th September and will run until the end of the academic year.
- -ASAs (After School Activities) run from Sunday to Thursday 2:00pm to 2:50pm. These are specialist activities and are charged.
- School buses will not run after ECAs or ASAs. Children will need to be collected from school at 2.50pm.
- Any students that are picked up late will be waiting in the Main Reception. If you are late on more than 2 occasions, your child will be removed from the ECA/ASA.
- Students must stay in the same ECA or ASA they have signed up for, for the duration of the activity.
- The number of students vary according to each activity.

#### **ANSWERS**

- ASAs are paid programs offered by outside providers for Hamilton's students and for the community.
- ASAs run from 2:00 PM until 8:30 PM on weekdays and all day long on weekends.
- To register your child for any ASA, please contact the provider directly. Contact details can be found on the flyers.
- Please contact each provider as prices vary based on the number of classes per week and the type of program you choose.
- Yes, we recommend parents provide their child with comfortable shorts, T-shirts, socks and running shoes for any sports activities; a cap for outdoor activities, a water bottle, a swimming suit, goggles and a swimming cap if you have registered your child in swimming classes. The providers will advise if any other equipment is needed or if any kit has to be purchased.
- Yes, the changing rooms are available in the Recreation Center.
- The school will ensure that your child is taken from his/her classroom to the venue of ASA from 2:00 pm to 3:00 pm.
- Due to safeguarding reasons, parents of children below six years old are kindly requested to collect their children from their classroom and direct them to the changing rooms in the Recreation Center.

- Where can I collect my child at 3:00 PM?
- What if I am late for the pickup of my child?
- What if my child is attending ASAs after 3:00 PM?

- Is the school bus transportation available for ASA.
- How many students participate in each ASA?
- Can I sign up anytime?

#### **ANSWERS**

- The collection point for the ASA at 3:00 pm is Black Box Theater (Gate no. 3). Security will guide you if needed.
- Please appreciate that our providers have other classes/ programs to follow.
   No after care programs are being offered.
- If your child's ASA starts after 3:00 pm, parents are asked to direct themselves to the venue of the ASA program. The provider will communicate the exact location once a child is registered. Please note that access for activities scheduled after 3:00 pm is through gate no. 5.
- We do not provide school bus service for ASAs yet. You will be informed if plans change in future.
- Each ASA has a different number of participants. Most programs require a minimum of 6 children to start.
- Yes, ASAs registrations are open anytime throughout the academic year.
